- Use of flash, tripods, selfie sticks and other photography accessories are not allowed.
- Professional photography, without prior approval, is not allowed.
- UCalgary photographers occasionally document the exhibitions. Signs are posted if they are shooting. Be aware that group members may be included in their shots.
- Non-observance of the above will result in visitors being asked to leave.
